**Re-Invitation of Bids (IFB) for
Supply of Specialized Search and Rescue Equipment (Lot-1: Ambulance and Lot-2: Mortuary
Van), Package No.: URP-DNCC/G-2,6, (IDA Credit No.: 5599-BD)**

1. The Government of Bangladesh (GOB) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Urban Resilience Project-DNCC Part, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for procurement of Specialized Search and Rescue Equipment (Ambulance and Mortuary Van).
2. The Urban Resilience Project-DNCC Part, Dhaka North City Corporation now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for procurement of Specialized Search and Rescue Equipment (Lot-1: Ambulance and Lot-2: Mortuary Van). The quantity of Ambulance is 10 and Mortuary Van is 04 with customization and a number of Search and Rescue equipment with it. The location of delivery of goods is Dhaka, Bangladesh. The delivery period is six months from the date of contract. Qualifications requirements of the bidders include: (i) general experience of manufacturing/supplying of the proposed goods is at least five years; (ii) specific experience of supply similar type of goods (similar functional and technical characteristics) of at least one contract value of USD 1125000.00 (One Million One Hundred and Twenty Five Thousand US Dollar) for Lot-1 and USD 375000.00 (Three Hundred and Seventy Five Thousand US Dollar) for Lot-2 or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency between January 01, 2012 and bid submission deadline; (iii) minimum total amount of available liquid asset and/or working capital and/or credit facility USD 1125000.00 (One Million One Hundred and Twenty Five Thousand US Dollar) for Lot-1 and USD 375000.00 (Three Hundred and Seventy Five Thousand US Dollar) for Lot-2 or equivalent. A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically shall be applied. More detail qualifications requirements are provided in the bid documents.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
4. 5. A Pre-Bid meeting will be held at 11.30 a.m. local time (GMT + 6 hrs.) on June 08, 2017 at the Office of the address below.
6. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a

nonrefundable fee of BDT 5000.00 (Five Thousand Bangladesh Taka) or US\$ 65.00 (Sixty Five US Dollar). The method of payment will be cash or bank draft.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 02.00 p.m. local time (GMT + 6 hrs.), July 10, 2017. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on 02.30 p.m. local time (GMT + 6 hrs.), July 10, 2017.
8. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of in favor of the "Project Director, Urban Resilience Project-DNCC part" in the form of an unconditional and irrevocable Bank Guarantee/Bank Draft/Pay Order from a reputed bank. The amount and currency of the bid security shall be for Lot-1: USD 31250.00 (Thirty One Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty US Dollar) or BDT 2.50 Million (Two and Half Million Bangladesh Taka) and for Lot-2: USD 10000.00 (Ten Thousand US Dollar) or BDT 800000.00 Million (Eight Hundred Thousand Bangladesh Taka).
